Continuing the ministry and influence of Adventist Education within the northwest region of the Dallas / Fort Worth Metro area through academics, spiritual growth, and development of character, while consistently providing a level of excellence that exceeds expectations.





With a population of 300,000+ in the demographic region, and 7,000+ households* (6.7%) placing Christian Education as a priority, KSCS is positioned for strong growth over the next five years.

For 25 years Knowledge Seekers Christian School has been a part of the Lewisville and Flower Mound community, and the only Adventist school north, and west, of the Dallas / Fort Worth airport. During this period of KSCS's existence, the community has grown exponentially, while also becoming a highly affluent area, with homes reaching the \$500K+ mark within 1/2 mile of the school.

While the demographics have changed around KSCS, the building and programs have not adjusted upward to reflect the needs of a more demanding community, and to adequately serve our current student body with the desired excellence.

What KSCS does not lack is passion and commitment from the teachers who lead our students daily, and love from the parents who send their children to KSCS, many from nearby Adventist churches, and the local community. The Lewisville SDA Church, located on the same property as KSCS, has consistently placed a priority on the health and viability of the school, positioning it today for growth.

The five year strategic plan will build off this strong foundation of commitment and passion, and bring KSCS up-to-date in appearance, technology, academics, and safety. By doing so it will become a destination school for our community.

The 2019-2024 strategic plan includes four key strategies for future focus.

ACADEMICS

- S.T.E.M. emphasis in all grade levels, utilizing the best tools and technology to do so.
- Partnerships with outside learning agencies to provide for students with special needs.
- Music programs, choir and instrument, for individual learning, and group presentations.

GROWTH

- Effective social media branding and marketing to increase awareness of KSCS.
- Creation of a referral program for current families who introduce new students.
- Leveraging the multi-grade classrooms as a benefit to student growth and development.

FACILITIES

- Renovation of facilities to increase student safety, create a positive learning environment.
- Completion of gymnasium in five years, with high school regulation-size basketball court.
- Addition of building within seven years for grades K-12 to accommodate 250 students.

INFLUENCE

- Stronger partnerships with SDA churches within the NW Metro area region.
- Connections with daycares, churches, and other possible sources of future students.
- Giving back to our community through programs, outreach, use of facilities.
